Whereas her outstanding contributions to the profession include her extensive research and writing about cataloging issues, which include more than 60 scholarly articles and numerous talks and lectures:

Whereas for over thirty years her outstanding text books have made subject cataloging understandable to thousands of students and practicing librarians;

Whereas she was member of the American Library Association since 1960 serving on numerous committees including the Subject Analysis Committee, the International Relations
